

**~Other Speakers M-R: Daily Portions:**

**"Lead me in your truth, and teach me." Â–Psalm 25:5**

What wonderful things does God sometimes show us in his word! How our eyes sometimes seem to be anointed with eye-salve "to behold wondrous things out of God's law!" (Psalm 119:18.) Sometimes in reading a chapter we see such beauty, such fullness, such sweetness, such glory in it, that it seems, as it were, to fill our very hearts.
