Selected Verses:

Matthew 6:22-23. The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light. 23But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness!

Hebrews 12:2. Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Opening:

Here is something that is in my soul: the word of Jesus when He says, â€œHow great is that darkness!â€• Did you ever see darkness? Now tell me, did you ever see darkness?
