All of sudden I was overcome with how the Lord is using Dan as His own instrument these days.

It really is very exciting and very interesting to watch all of this unfold.

It is also very humbling for me. Many times I have to repent of my own envy of all that Dan gets to do and all the impact he gets to make on others. How exciting and rewarding it must be! But on the other hand, the Lord has His plans laid out and there are obviously reasons why He is using Dan as a mouthpiece. I am grateful to be a part of all of this, to help support and nourish as much as possible. However God desires to get His glory- so be it- as long as He gets it!

Feeling sorry for myself, I recently let Dan know my feelings of disappointment, that here I am still at home with the kids. He already has so much to do- yet the Lord is using him to minister to others even at his lunch hour. Dan's answer?- "That's because He's preparing you for something REALLY big." He knows just what to say. :)

I am grateful for the work that the Lord is doing in our lives as a team. The key is that we have put the Lord's will first. His need for us to be obedient to Him comes first and foremost- before our own will, needs, or wants. I really am in awe of how the Lord worked this all out.
