- ARE YOU TRULY SAVED?

This was a sermon preached at Teen Mania Ministries to approximately 60 summer volunteers. It was a hot and strong message about death, sin, hell and the cross. Others have told me that it was a powerfully anointed message. And I had the blessing of watching many get right with God through prayer that night.

I had preached at this very same event last year on "Happiness or Holiness". A few people from this recent meeting said that it was last years meeting that made them get serious about Christianity and to turn around to serve God.

The dark hour in which we live calls for much private prayer and much public preaching, if we are ever to see a revival in America. I am told by those who attended this service that it was a powerful message.

It speaks directly to our current need within our churches to be about the task of private prayer and devotion and engaged in the battle for souls. At the current rate of evangelism we are looking at a 4% Christian generation in the near future. Praise God for believers who are waging the war against the gates of hell where others are asleep. I pray that this message will wake up some sleepy Christians for the glory of Christ!"
