His own words were: "I felt so ashamed and not worthy of forgiveness." He then told me that he felt something tingle all over his body and it remained with him the rest of the evening and that night he had the best sleep he ever had for a long long time, not waking up in the middle of night and feeling refreshed in the morning!

I can testify an immediate change in him that morning... normally he is very sluggish and drags his feet to work; lazy and doesn't like to do a lot, but that morning he sped off to work and we covered more ground than ever, he was leading the charge! Of a truth, when you have an experience with God you are changed! I don't believe he is born again yet, but I have been exhorting him a lot about it and the need to press in to receive grace through the blood of Jesus Christ. He has said "I am that lost sheep. It's just a matter of time."

Praise God! He is on the road to salvation, and God is doing it, answering the prayers offered up on his behalf!
