I live in Canada and our health care is paid by the government through our tax dollars. It's the best system that one can have. I never pay a cent to go see the Doctor. However I do have to pay \$10 dollars if it's medical exam for my job. And those that need Cancer treatment is not covered any more thus you still need some coverage.
