Smith Wigglesworth: Apostle of Faith

but I doubt that there are any recordings. Stanley Frodsham was an Englishman who settled in the USA and was the editor of the Assemblies of God official magazine, the Pentecostal Evangel' for almost 30 years.

There is a sobering prophecy given by Frodsham and an article which says that Frodsham become identified with a new move in pentecostal circles linked with the latter rain teaching;  
Perhaps the two strongest challenges internally to Pentecostal thought during this period took place on the grassroots level. The first was the 'latter rain' movement with its emphasis on 'new prophetic light' of understanding the Bible, the enlightening of hearts by the Spirit, the importance of the Feast of Tabernacles, as well as the Apostolic and Prophetic ministries within the church (Eph. 4:11). Some of the more noted adherents to this movement were Stanley Frodsham, who resigned his position as editor of Pentecostal Evangel to follow and participate within the movement, the Elim Fellowship, and many other independent Pentecostal churches

The whole article is very interesting in giving a comprehensive overview of pentecostal theology over the past 100 years.
