Quote: ------Ukraine's outgoing President, Leonid Kuchma, raised the spectre of civil war engulfing the country after election officials declared y esterday that the Prime Minister, Viktor Yanukovych, had won the bitterly fought presidential contest. - The Independent UK - 25 November 2004

The history of the Ukraine indicates that the present unrest is another evidence of nationalistic identity arising. The Ukra ine might have been a melting pot but in fact the nation is the fault line between Eastern Orthodoxy and Western Catholi cism. For those wanting more detailed information may I suggest Catholicism in the Ukraine. I cannot vouch for the unde rlying theology of this site (or even for my own;-)) but there are some valuable insights here.

The Orthodox burial caves and the outwardly beautiful shrines of the Monastery of the Caves are said to be the A'mothe rÂ' of Russian Orthodoxy. I discerned the same spirits within them as previously encountered in Buddhist temples in NE India; dark and murderous. The monks in the tourist kiosks had just begun to re-sell the Â"Protocols of the Learned Eld ers of ZionÂ" in Russian. This virulent anti-Jewish Â'documentÂ' was the cause of much of the Jewish pogroms in the e arly 20th century in Russia. (If you have seen Â'Fiddler on the RoofÂ' -still my favourite film - you know the mood. If yo u havenÂ't seen it, I recommend it. Take your hanky.)

There is a phenomenon unique to the Ukraine in the Ukrainian Catholic Church, also known as Greek Catholic or Uniate Church. It was a unique compromise following Orthodox rituals, but recognizing the Pope in Rome. It is primarily in We stern Ukraine; Uniate priests can marry. There has been extreme bitterness between the Uniate Church and the Orthod ox Church. The Uniate Church was forced underground in 1946 but reappeared in the 1980s.

The consequence of this is that eastern half of the Ukraine is instinctively eastward facing and hence towards Russia, w hile the western half is instinctively westward facing towards Europe. The Ukrainian language is highly prized in the wes tern half while in the eastern half many only speak Russian.

There are signs that Russia would welcome a return to some aspects of the USSR and the prime candidates would be B elarus and next, Ukraine. Political leaders in both of the countries would also favour some re-establishment of the older bloc. Many older Pentecostals in Russia have always believed that Communism was the beast whose deadly head wou nd would recover. (Rev 13:12) and fear its revival. But there are older and, to my mind, more dangerous forces at work i n the old domains of Eastern Orthodoxy.

I was in Kiev when Ukraine declared its independence from the USSR. A giant statue of Lenin which dominated the mai n square had been pulled down leaving just the plinth. It was a poignant sight and spoke to me of a nation which had de posed its god but had nothing to replace it. Into the vacuum flooded pornography and the occult. I recall the first Â'free enterprise A' subway book sellers where almost their whole stock was one or the other. Into the vacuum flooded the odd est representatives of Â'western christianityÂ'; anything weird and wonderful was guaranteed to flourish in Kiev.

Economically, the black market took over. Train tickets were not available in the stations because the black-marketeers had bought the whole monthÂ's supply and were selling them in the streets with a 400% markup.

The Ukraine is a nuclear power straddling the fault lines between East and West and there are tectonic shifts taking plac e among the nations in these days. Pray for the Ukraine.
