I have been thinking about the role of blood in the Christian's life lately. Honestly, all the pat answers and explanations I have heard over the years to explain the role and importance of blood have left me unfulfilled. Leviticus 12 has been a passage I have been visiting lately. In this passage the Spirit speaks to the people of Israel about a woman's duties after bearing a child. The issue of blood is a central theme here. A woman is instructed that she is unclean for many days as a result of the blood from child birth. This is no small thing either because it requires a sacrifice equal to that made on the Day of Atonement,

Sin in the flesh is condemned and the life of the flesh is in the blood, so because of my sin, my blood is required in judgment so sin in the flesh is condemned to death, "you shall surely die".
