Quote:

For starters, the greek word for 'love' is the same used in 1 Cor. 13 (ref: Strong's G26). and 'grow up' is used in a very natural sense like a tree will grow, a child will grow, it's natural to grow (ref: Strong's G837).

Based on this entire chapter, Paul is giving some life changing advice to the Church.

Eph. 4:17-20 are encouraging the believer to 'not walk in the futility of their mind', 'became callous', 'for the practice of every kind of impurity with greediness'.

Eph. 4:22-24 speak of 'lay aside the old self', 'speak truth each one of you with his neighbor', 'for we are members of one another'.

Eph. 4:26-32 speak of practical matters 'be angry yet do not sin', 'he who steals must no longer steal, performing with his own hands what is good', and 'let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth', 'so that it will give grace to those who hear', 'don't grieve the Holy Spirit', 'let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, slander be put away', 'be kind to one another, tender-hearted', finally 'just as God in Christ also has forgiven'.

So, after some prayer, I feel God prompting me to stop with my desire to expound on this. I set out to write an article but now I feel God set out for me to write scripture. Be blessed by His word.
