There is a book available at most area Wal-Marts called *Jesus Freaks: Stories of Revolutionaries Who Changed Their World, Fearing God, Not Man*. ISBN: 0764227467 It is a joint venture by *DC Talk* (the contemporary Christian music group) and *Voice of the Martyrs*. However, the book is authored by several anonymous writers. The book is a compilation of many stories of missionaries and pioneers of faith. There are several other books in this "series." Two of these books are dedicated to those who have lost their lives for the faith (both recently and in the distant past).

While I am not a big fan of *DC Talk*, I was greatly touched by the stories found in the books. The stories are well-told and greatly inspiring. And the books are available for about \$10 at your local Wal-Mart.
